ACTIONS


Develop/include guest lectures, experiential learning opportunities, and curricula on One Health for **all levels and disciplines** within the professions of animal, public, and ecosystem health.



ACTIONS

Develop culturally appropriate community based training and educational programs on the relevance/importance of One Health.

ACTIONS

Educate and empower political leadership to take action and define policies for “One Health”



ACTIONS

Utilize a broad spectrum of educational and training tools, including technology and media that take into account the learning styles of the various groups.



ACTIONS

Provide existing animal, public health, and ecosystem/environmental professionals with training and educational opportunities on One Health through existing professional organizations. (continuing education)



ACTIONS

Educate funders (i.e. governments, businesses, NGOs, banks, foundations, commodity groups, etc) on the importance of funding research, training and educational program on One Health.
